

PRE-USE INSPECTION CHECKLIST

Hand & Portable Power Tools

Some portable power tools require a more thorough inspection. Be sure to check the manufacturer's manual for more advanced power tools.

Before using hand tools inspect for the following:	
☐ The outside of the tool is free of grease, oil and accumulated foreign matter	
☐ The tool has no visible cracks in jaws or handle	
☐ Blades or bits are not damaged, cracked, etc.	
☐ Handles are not cracked, damaged or loose from heads of hammers, axe mauls and other similar tools	: S
☐ Tips of screwdrivers, chisels or other similar tools show no excessive wead ☐ Gripping surfaces on pliers, wrenches or other similar tools are not worn ☐ Tools such as chisels and punches do not have mushroomed heads	
☐ Cutting tools such as chisels and axes are sharp	
☐ Tool appears to be in generally good condition	
Before using portable power tools inspect for the following:	
☐ The outside of the tool is free of grease, oil and accumulated foreign matter	
☐ Tool power-source shows no damage (cord, airline, battery, etc.)	
☐ Tool is double insulated and tool housing is not damaged	
\square If so equipped, electrical cord third prong (ground) is intact	
☐ All shields, guards or attachments required are present	
☐ Rotating or moving parts of tool are guarded to prevent physical contact	t
☐ Tool is not leaking fluid such as gasoline, oil etc.	
☐ Blades or bits are not damaged, cracked, excessively worn, etc.	
☐ Tool appears to be in generally good condition	
☐ Proper PPE is available
